The Social Intervention Group (SIG) at Columbia University is seeking applicants for a postdoctoral research position beginning Summer 2018. The postdoctoral researchers will receive mentorship and experience working with interdisciplinary researchers as they pursue extramurally-funded domestic or international research projects related to HIV, substance use, violence, criminal justice settings and populations, and implementation science. Early career scientists seeking to apply, develop, and/or test more sophisticated and new quantitative analytical methods particularly are encouraged to apply.

The postdoctoral researcher may receive up to three years of support.
